Any class member who misses two class sessions will be asked to leave the program and will not receive a tuition refund. **If you are unable to make this commitment, please do not apply at this time.**

If admitted to the LPC program, you (or your company or sponsoring organization) agree to pay \$1,350 in tuition, which is non-refundable. Tuition is due no later than Aug. 1, 2009. The tuition fee covers all program costs, including the room and board at the orientation retreat and the annual Leadership Conference. We also offer installment payments.
